PROTECT LIFE AND TRADITION

- pushed and gained passage of the Fetal Homicide Bill to criminalize an act against a mother during pregnancy that causes harm to her unborn.
- fought for and gained passage of an amendment to define marriage as a union between a man and woman.

SUPPORT EDUCATION

CONTAIN HEALTH INSURANCE COSTS

Mike’s legislative experience, his education in math and statistics, and his past work in cost analysis and insurance have prepared him to be part of a long-term solution for Kentucky’s health care crisis. To improve access to quality care, Mike supports fairness in medical coverage by stabilizing costs and offering more choices for consumers through competition.
